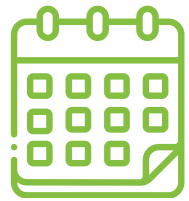

- Don't forget to visit the website on a regular basis. Ads are being posted throughout the summer, it is up to you to keep yourselves updated!



Please bear in mind 3 major criteria while looking for a Crous housing (valid for other types of housing):

- • Be mindful of your **BUDGET**! On every housing search platforms, including that of the Crous, filters are at your disposal to best tweak your research;
- • Be mindful of the **MODALITIES**, of your housing as well! Studio, flatshare, one-bedroom, two-bedroom... the surface and features (and thus your rent) vary according to the ads;
- • At last, be mindful of the **LOCATION** of your residence! You will be studying either on the Carlone Campus, in the Western area of Nice (06200) or on the Georges Méliès Campus in the heart of Cannes la Bocca (06150). Both cities are very well served areas, yet it is important to check if your housing-campus journey is feasible and relatively short.

2- STUDENT RESIDENCES

If you cannot find the housing that suits you best in a Crous residence, there exist many more platforms on which you can search for housing in student residences.

They are not executively linked to the State as are those of the Crous, yet they remain reliable and offer preferential rates. What's more, they are located at the heart of Nice!

4- COHABITATION SOLIDAIRE INTERGÉNÉRATIONNELLE



- CoHomly : You live with a family (parents and children) for a very low rent in exchange for small services during the week (babysitting, tutoring...).

- ToitchezMoi : You are housed year-round for free or almost free in exchange for about ten hours per week of help (petsitting, gardening...).

- AFEV (KAPS) : The Association of the Student Foundation for the City offers solidarity-based shared housing (KAPS – Co-living with a Social Project), where you participate in neighborhood activities about 5 hours per week.

- Ensemble2générations : This platform offers plans ranging from €10/month to €400/month. You live with a senior, and your plan determines your hours of availability and presence at the home.

- ToitEnTandem (Cohabilis PACA) : This association offers co-living with and at a senior's home for €30/month, in exchange for more or less regular presence and varying levels of autonomy in the evenings and weekends, depending on the agreement.

- Habitat et Humanisme : The association created the intergenerational residence Fabrice Cayol, which welcomes you with very affordable rent. In return, you commit to a solidarity and community project.

- Université Côte d'Azur: the University offers this guide as soon as you get in Nice or Cannes. You will find many items including housing.

- Emails: please do check your mailbox on a regular basis (both personal and university mail addresses)! We often send you useful information, namely links to websites and platforms which will help you through your housing searching process.



- Caisse d'Allocations Familiales (CAF): this measure from the State allows you to get conditional support to pay your rent, according to specific criteria. Here is a simulator to check if you are eligible to the various supports (APL, ALS, ALF...).

GARANTME

Most of the time, in order to be able to book a rental, you need a guarantor. If you have found your housing but do not have a guarantor and thus cannot book it, this platform, GarantMe, allows you to provide the owner or the agency with a proof that states your reliability.
