## BUS ET TRAMWAYS

The Lignes d'Azur network covers the territory of the Nice Côte d'Azur Metropolis. It includes:

- 3 tram lines that serve key locations in Nice (city center, hospitals, university campuses, tourist attractions, etc.). Since January 2025, line 3 offers a direct connection between Saint-Isidore and Port Lympia every 7 minutes;
- 174 bus lines that complement the trams: regular lines, tram-effect lines, Snow lines, intercity lines, specific lines, on-demand lines...



## MOBIL'AZUR

Mobil'Azur is the Lignes d'Azur unit that is designed for the disabled. It is an on-demand service, you need to book your journey and a van takes you from one address to the other. The same rate as that of a single-trip ticket: 1,70€.



## CAMPUS CARLONE

To get to the Carlone Campus, you need to get to the Magnan tramway stop through Line 2 or to the Magnan/Promenade bus stop through Line 12. Then, take the bus line 6 to Croix de Berra and get off at the "Faculté de Lettres" stop.

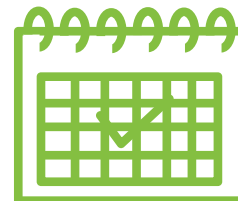
### SINGLE-TRIP TICKETS (& MORE)

Within the Lignes d'Azur network, you can choose to travel casually (without a subscription). You need to buy a nontransferable, reload card (2€) or download the mobile app, then buy your tickets:

- 1-trip: €1,70€, valid on city lines, including connections, during 74 minutes;
- 10-trip Pack: 17€ for 10 trips;
- 1-day Pass: 7€ (24h) ;
- 2-day Pass: 13€ (48h) ;
- 7-day Pass: 20€.

### MONTHLY SUBSCRIPTION

If your trips are more frequent within the Métropole Nice Côte d'Azur, you can also opt for the monthly subscription, with the "under 26" rate:

For 22,50€ per month + 1€ for administrative fees, your subscription grants you unlimited trips on all city lines (buses and tramways) of the network.

Papers you need for your application:

- A form of ID;
- An identity photograph.

### YEARLY SUBSCRIPTION

You can also choose the yearly subscription, which allows you to pay in 10 installments, free of charge, with debits via IBAN. The "under 26" rate also applies:

For 180€ per year + 12€ for administrative fees, you get unlimited trips all over the network. Papers you need for your application:

- A form of ID;
- An identity photograph;

## 3- OTHER MODES OF TRANSPORTATION



### SCOOTERS YEGO

Yego is an electric scooter sharing service. Recognizable by their Vespa-style design and green color, the Yego fleet includes 200 scooters in Nice, and they are accessible throughout the city: no dock or station required! Simply download the app via the App Store or Google Play Store, which locates the nearest vehicle to you.

The rates are: €0.39/minute, plus packs at €10, €30, €50...

The price includes two helmets, insurance, a service available 24/7. You are also assured of constantly charged vehicles.

The conditions to meet are as follows:

- be 18 years old or older;
- have a driving license (A1, A2, AM, B). French, European Union and United Kingdom licenses are accepted. For foreign licenses, an official translation will be required;
- create an account and upload your ID, your license and your payment method (bank details, credit card...)

### LIME AND PONY

Since February 2024, LIME and PONY services have replaced the former Vélo Bleu, offering electric and regular bikes for sharing across 12 municipalities of the Nice Côte d'Azur Metropolis.

How it works

To use these services, download the LIME or PONY app via the App Store or Google Play Store, create an account and locate the nearest bike to you.

Current rates

Standard pricing:

- €1 unlock fee + €0.23 per minute
- Approximately €5.99 for 30 minutes

Subscriptions:

- Monthly subscriptions from €25 at LIME and €29 at PONY
- Preferential rates for holders of a Réseau Zou! and/or Envibus subscription

# FROM NICE TO CANNES

## COMMUTING FROM NICE TO CANNES / FROM CANNES TO NICE

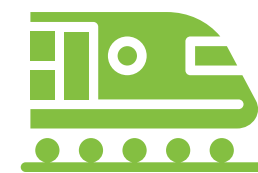


### VIA BUSES & TRAMS

To go from Nice to Cannes using the bus and tramway (via the Lignes d'Azur network), you need to get to the "Parc Phoenix" stop, in Nice, using the tramway line 2 (which you can access from Downtown Nice). Then, take the 620 bus line (formerly Line 200). The first stop in Cannes is "Mire Juan", but the terminal, "Gare SNCF" gets you much closer to Downtown Cannes.

To go from Cannes to Nice, take the 620 bus line at the SNCF train station, for instance, and get off at the terminus, "Parc Phoenix". Then, take the tramway line 2, towards Port Lympia in order to get to Nice Downtown and reach the tramway line 1.

Line 620 is now operated by the ZOU! network (South region) in connection with the Lignes d'Azur network.



### VIA THE TRAIN

To go from Nice to Cannes using the train, you need to get to the "Nice Ville" train station via the tramway line 1, "Gare Thiers" stop. Pick your train, go to the platform, and get off at the "Cannes Voyageurs" stop or the "Cannes la Bocca" stop if you are going to the Georges Méliès campus.

To go from Cannes to Nice using the train, you need to get to the SNCF "Cannes" train station if you are in Downtown Cannes, "Cannes la Bocca" or "Les Bosquets" if you are coming from the Georges Méliès campus. Pick your train, go to the platform. Get off at the "Saint-Augustin" stop if you are going West (06200), at "Nice-Ville" if you are going Downtown (06000), at "Nice-Riquier" if you are going East (06300).

Average journey time: approximately 28 minutes between Nice and Cannes.

## 1- PALM BUS: THE NETWORK



The Palm Bus network serves the Cannes–Pays de Lérins area. It includes:

- 2 Express lines (A and B) serving key locations in Cannes and surrounding areas (SNCF train stations, shopping centers, university campus...);
- around thirty regular bus lines;
- 3 local shuttle services;
- several summer shuttles;
- 5 night lines (Palm Night)..



Palm on Demand – Persons with Reduced Mobility (PAD-PMR) is the Palm Bus network service dedicated to people with reduced mobility.

It is an on-demand transport service: trips are booked in advance by the passenger, from point A to point B, at a flat fare of €1.70, the same as a standard Palm Bus ticket.

Access to the service requires prior registration (€9 for first-time enrollment).



### CAMPUS GEORGES MÉLIÈS

To get to the Georges Méliès Campus, you need to get to the Cannes la Bocca train station, to get to the Sainte-Marguerite bus stop, to take the bus line 1 to Alfred de Musset, to get off at the Palais des Victoires stop.

You can also take the Express line A at the same stop, to Centre Commercial Minelle via Cineum and get off at the Saint-Cassien stop.

## 2- PALM BUS: RATES



### SINGLE-TRIP TICKETS (& MORE)

Within the Palm Bus network, you can travel occasionally. You can pay directly with your bank card on board the bus, or buy a rechargeable nominative card for €2, valid for 4 years, then purchase your passes (1 day, 3 days, 7 days).

- 1 trip: €1.80, valid on urban lines, including connections, for 59 minutes;
- 10 trips pass: €10.50 for 10 trips;
- 1 day pass: €4.60 (24h);
- 3 days pass: €9.20 (72h);
- 7 days pass: €17.00.

### MONTHLY SUBSCRIPTION

If your travels are more frequent within the heart of the Cannes-Pays de Lérins network, you also have the option to choose the monthly subscription, the PASS JEUNE 31 DAYS, eligible for the under-26 rate:

For €23.50 / month, your subscription offers unlimited travel on all urban lines of the network.

Documents to present:

- Identity card;
- Proof of residence;
- Recent color photo.
- The PASS starts from the first validation, and the subscription is loaded onto a nominative card with a support fee of €9.

### YEARLY SUBSCRIPTION

You also have the option of the annual subscription, the PASS JEUNES 365 DAYS, which allows you to pay in 12 interest-free installments by direct debit. This offer is also eligible for the under-26 rate:

For €135 per year + €9 processing fees, enjoy unlimited travel on the network.

Documents to present:

- Identity card;
- Proof of residence;
- Bank account details (RIB) if paying by installments;
- Recent color photo.
- The PASS starts at the first validation, and the subscription is loaded onto a nominative card.

# III- SNCF TRAINS



## RÉGION SUD : TER ET LER

The Région Sud network covers the Région PACA area (six departments: 04, 05, 06, 13, 83, 84) and is divided in two parts. It includes:

- the TER network (Trains Express Régionaux) and the Chemins de Fer de Provence network;
- the LER network (Lignes Express Régionales) which includes 23 Express bus lines within the Région SUD and 38 local lines including 3 on-demand lines within the Alpes-Maritimes department.



## PASS ZOU ! ÉTUDES

The PASS ZOU! Études is designed for young people aged 3 to 25 who are enrolled in school, apprentices, trainees in vocational training, students in health and social training, as well as volunteers in civic service. It offers unlimited access to buses and trains on the regional ZOU! network (TER and LER) from September 1, 2025, to August 31, 2026, including weekends, holidays, and leisure trips.

The price is €90 per year.

Documents to provide:

- School certificate (or equivalent);
- Identity card;
- Recent identity photo meeting standards.

# PASS SUDAZUR

## PASS SUDAZUR

The PASS SUDAZUR grants you unlimited access to the Région SUD TER network + to the city and intercity networks in the 06 department. The pass works either in a monthly or a yearly subscription, and it costs about 82€ per month (rates vary according to how many zones you pick).

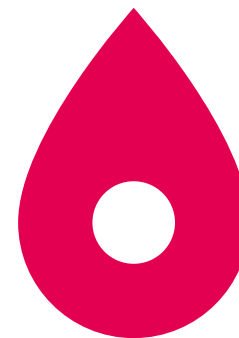
## NICE: LIGNES D'AZUR MOBILITY CENTER

The main agency for Lignes d'Azur is located in downtown Nice:

33 boulevard Dubouchage, 06000 Nice  
(tram stop L1 Jean Médecin)

## NICE: LIME & PONY

The Vélobleu service ended in 2024. Since then, bike sharing has been managed by the private operators Lime and Pony, accessible only via their mobile apps.



## CANNES: PALM BUS MOBILITY HOUSE

The main Palm Bus agency is located in downtown Cannes:

(Express line A bus stop Hôtel de Ville)
