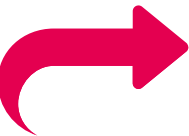
INCOME

CONDITIONS

You need to meet a few conditions before being allowed to work a student job. Indeed, you will need:

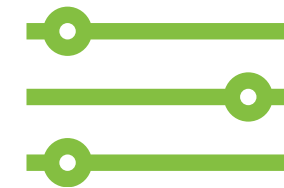
- a Long-Stay Visa valid as Residence Permit for Students
- a contract which does not take up over 60% of the time (under 964 hours per year).



TYPES OF CONTRACT

Several options exist. You can choose a CDD (short-term contract), a half-time contract, a temporary contract...

You can also work within the University, as many department offer student jobs.



OTHER OPTIONS

Besides working for a company, other types of student jobs exist:

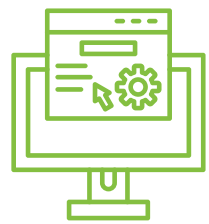
- Babysitting

1- IN CASE OF PRECARIOUSNESS

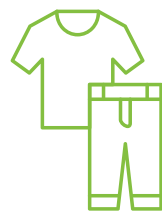
If you are on a limited budget and cannot afford to go grocery shopping in supermarkets, several options exist:

- Agoraé, an outreach student grocery (FACE06). They welcome you with no means test:
 - 9, rue Alsace Lorraine, 06000 Nice (Monday through Friday from 3PM to 5PM)
 - You can also visit the solidarity-based Restaurant on Tuesdays and Thursdays, for lunch and dinner
 - 12, rue Giacobi, 06300 Nice (Wednesday through Friday, from 5PM to 8PM)
 - +33 9 52 56 56 06
- A la croisée des besoins, 4 rue Vernier, 06000 Nice (+33 7 82 05 00 51)
- Think of solidarity-based mobile apps such as TooGoodToGo, Frigo Magic, Delivr'aide
