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In case of a medical emergency, you can go to the ER in the Nice and Cannes hospitals ([L'Archet](#), [Pasteur](#), [Simone Veil](#)), and in other emergency centres of the department ([Mougins and Saint-Laurent-du-Var Institut Arnault Tzanck](#), [Antibes hospital](#), [Parc Impérial practice](#)).

In case of a social emergency, if you are without housing, cannot eat properly, are not safe, several devices and teams of volunteers are here to help and rescue you:

BUS ET TRAMWAYS

The Lignes d'Azur network covers the Métropole Nice Côte d'Azur area. It includes:

- 3 tramway lines which cover key locations in Nice (downtown, hospitals, university campuses, tourist attractions...);
- almost 150 bus lines which take over the tramway lines, Snow Lines, intercity lines, special lines, on-demand lines...



MOBIL'AZUR

Mobil'Azur is the Lignes d'Azur unit that is designed for the disabled. It is an on-demand service, you need to book your journey and a van takes you from one address to the other. The same rate as that of a single-trip ticket: 1,70€.



CAMPUS CARLONE

To get to the Carlone Campus, you need to get to the Magnan tramway stop through Line 2 or to the Magnan/Promenade bus stop through Line 12. Then, take the bus line 6 to Croix de Berra and get off at the "Faculté de Lettres" stop.

SINGLE-TRIP TICKETS (& MORE)

Within the Lignes d'Azur network, you can choose to travel casually (without a subscription). You need to buy a nontransferable, reload card (2€) or download the mobile app, then buy your tickets:

- 1-trip 0€1,70€, valid on city lines, including connections, during 74 minutes;
- 10-trip Pack: 17€ for 10 trips;
- 1-day Pass: 7€ (24h) ;
- 2-day Pass: 13€ (48h) ;
- 7-day Pass: 20€.

MONTHLY SUBSCRIPTION

If your trips are more frequent within the Métropole Nice Côte d'Azur, you can also opt for the monthly subscription, with the "under 26" rate:

For 22,50€ per month + 1€ for administrative fees, your subscription grants you unlimited trips on all city lines (buses and tramways) of the network.

- An identity photograph.

YEARLY SUBSCRIPTION

You can also choose the yearly subscription, which allows you to pay in 10 installments, free of charge, with debits via IBAN. The "under 26" rate also applies:

For 180€ per year + 12€ for administrative fees, you get unlimited trips all over the network.

- Student card or proof of enrolment.

3- OTHER MODES OF TRANSPORTATION



SCOOTERS YEGO

Yego is an electric scooter rental service. Distinctively pastel-green and Vespa-design-like, there are 200 Yego scooters in Nice and they can be rented anywhere in the city: no station or collecting point! You only need to download the mobile application via the [App Store](#) or the [Play Store](#), which geo-references the nearest vehicle for you. Here are the rates: 0,36€ per minute, then 10€, 30€, 50€ packs...

Fees include a helmet, an insurance, a 24/7 available service. You are also ensured that the scooters' batteries are systematically charged.

The terms you need to abide to are:

- being at least 18 years old;
- owning a driver's license (A1, A2, AM, B). French, EU, and UK licenses are accepted. If you have a foreign license, you will be asked the officially translated version;
- creating an account and depositing your form of ID, your driver's license and your payment method (IBAN, credit card...).

VÉLO BLEU ET E-VÉLO BLEU

Vélo Bleu (Blue Bike) is a mechanical and electric bike rental system (175 stations and 1750 bikes), which covers the Nice, Saint-Laurent-du-Var and Cagnes-sur-Mer areas. To rent a Vélo Bleu, you need to fill the [online form](#). For a consistent use, download the app via the [App Store](#) or the [Play Store](#). Subscription costs:

- 3€ a day; 7€ a week; 15€ a month; 30€ a year + 30 minutes free, 1€ the second half-hour, 2€ the additional hour;
- If you choose the Lignes d'Azur YEARLY subscription, you can have a special rate: 15€ per year instead of 30€.

To rent an e-Vélo Bleu (electric Blue Bike), download the app via the [App Store](#) or the [Play Store](#), create an account and get to a station. Subscription costs:

- 4€ a day; 80€ a year + 30 minutes free, 2€ the additional half-hour.
- Your STUDENT status grants you a 20€ yearly subscription.

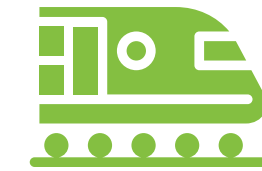
COMMUTING FROM NICE TO CANNES / FROM CANNES TO NICE



VIA BUSES & TRAMS

To go from Nice to Cannes using the bus and tramway (via the Lignes d'Azur network), you need to get to the "Parc Phoenix" stop, in Nice, using the tramway line 2 (which you can access from Downtown Nice). Then, take the 620 bus line (formerly Line 200). The first stop in Cannes is "Mire Juan", but the terminal, "Gare SNCF" gets you much closer to Downtown Cannes.

To go from Cannes to Nice, take the 620 bus line at the SNCF train station, for instance, and get off at the terminus, "Parc Phoenix". Then, take the tramway line 2, towards Port Lympia in order to get to Nice Downtown and reach the tramway line 1.



VIA THE TRAIN

To go from Nice to Cannes using the train, you need to get to the "Nice Ville" train station via the tramway line 1, "Gare Thiers" stop. Pick your train, go to the platform, and get off at the "Cannes Voyageurs" stop or the "Cannes la Bocca" stop if you are going to the Georges Méliès campus.

To go from Cannes to Nice using the train, you need to get to the SNCF "Cannes" train station if you are in Downtown Cannes, "Cannes la Bocca" or "Les Bosquets" if you are coming from the Georges Méliès campus. Pick your train, go to the platform. Get off at the "Saint-Augustin" stop if you are going West (06200), at "Nice-Ville" if you are going Downtown (06000), at "Nice-Riquier" if you are going East (06300).

1- PALM BUS: THE NETWORK



BUS LINES

The Palm Bus network covers the Cannes-Pays de Lérins area. It includes:

- 2 Express lines A and B which cover key locations in Cannes and around (train stations, malls, university campus...);
- 34 bus lines including 3 shuttles, 4 summer shuttles, 1 night line.



PAD-PMR

Palm à la Demande pour les Personnes à Mobilité Réduite (PAD-PMR), which stands for Palm on Demand - Disabled is the Palm Bus unit that is designed for the disabled. It consists in on-demand journeys, trips are booked in advance by the passenger from point A to point B. The same rate as a single-trip ticket applies: 1,60€.



CAMPUS GEORGES MÉLIÈS

To get to the Georges Méliès Campus, you need to get to the Cannes la Bocca train station, to get to the Sainte-Marguerite bus stop, to take the bus line 1 to Alfred de Musset, to get off at the Palais des Victoires stop. You can also take the Express line A at the same stop, to Centre Commercial Minelle via Cineum and get off at the Saint-Cassien stop.

2- PALM BUS: RATES



SINGLE-TRIP TICKETS (& MORE)

Within the Palm Bus network, you can choose to travel casually (without a subscription). You can pay with your credit card once you board the bus, or you can buy a nontransferable, rechargeable card for 2€, valid for 4 years, then get your tickets (1-day, 3-day, 7-day passes).

- 1-trip ticket: 1,60€, valid on city lines, connections included for 59 minutes;
- 10-trip Pass: 13€ for 10 trips;
- 1-day Pass: 4,30€ (24h) ;
- 3-day Pass: 8,60€ (72h) ;
- 7-day Pass: 16€.

For 22€ per month, your subscription grants you unlimited trips on all city lines of the network.

- A proof of address.

III- SNCF TRAINS



RÉGION SUD : TER ET LER

The Région Sud network covers the Région PACA area (six departments: 04, 05, 06, 13, 83, 84) and is divided in two parts. It includes:

- the TER network (Trains Express Régionaux) and the Chemins de Fer de Provence network;
- the LER network (Lignes Express Régionales) which includes 23 Express bus lines within the Région SUD and 38 local lines including 3 on-demand lines within the Alpes-Maritimes department.



PASS ZOU ! ÉTUDES

The PASS ZOU ! Études is designed for students. It grants you unlimited access to the TER and LER networks of the Région SUD. Valid from September 1st to August 31st, the subscription costs 90€ per year and remains valid during weekends, holidays and on "leisure" journeys.
